These next two meetings are important for us since we will be nominating our Officers for the next Columbian Year. If you are inclined to serve or know of a brother knight who you think would like to serve, please attend our Officer's meeting this Thursday on ZOOM and enter the discussion.

In addition to our Officer's and Membership meetings we have the following events that we are supporting and look forward to. God is Faithful!

Do you know the peace and security of the GOOD SHEPHERD who watches over His own? The Old Testament often speaks of God as shepherd of his people, Israel. The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want (Psalm 23:1). Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, you who lead Joseph like a flock! (Psalm 80:1) We are his people, and the sheep of his pasture (Psalm 100:3). The Messiah is also pictured as the shepherd of God's people: He will feed his flock like a shepherd, He will gather the lambs in His arms (Isaiah 40:11). Jesus says He is the Good SHEPHERD who will risk His life to seek out and save the stray sheep (Matthew 18:12, Luke 15:4). He is the Shepherd and Guardian of our souls (1 Peter 2:25).

Our Council is supporting the living rosary in the Grotto on May 19 after the 12pm Mass. The Pro Life, Faith Formation, and our Council are working together to promote this prayer filled event. Our Council will be providing rosaries and prayer cards for those who need them.

MEMORIAL DAY SERVICE AT THE CCOP CEMETERY

Monday, May 27, will be our celebration of the Mass at the CCOP Cemetery. More information to follow. Please place this on your calendar. It is a great way to honor our living and deceased military service personnel.

NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Jesus is calling us deeper into our faith. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Catholic faith. CCOP has been focusing on renewing our understanding of the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ. This is the focus of the whole Church. The National Eucharist Revival is one aspect of this reality. There are two focus areas for the 2024 National Revival: 1. A pilgrimage with several separate legs, and 2. A Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis.

The western leg is the Junipero Serra pilgrimage from San Francisco to Indianapolis, Indiana. It will start on May 17 at the Mission Delores Basilica. The whole route will be walked by 6 volunteers with a priest leading and displaying the Eucharist as they go. They have many stops along the way and welcome walkers to join them for some portion of the pilgrimage. The plan is to arrive in Indianapolis, Indiana prior to July 17 when the Eucharistic Congress starts. The Eucharistic Congress is being held from July 17 to 21 at Lucas Oil Stadium. Faith in Action – Life



The Knights of Columbus will be conducting a baby bottle drive during the month of May to raise funds for local pregnancy resource centers. These centers provide counseling and loving support, including prenatal care, ultrasounds, childbirth and parenting classes, adoption support services, material support (including such things as maternity clothes, diapers, baby clothes, formula, baby furniture), abortion and miscarriage healing, and grief recovery counseling. Funds raised this year will be augmented via the Knights of Columbus Aid and Support After Pregnancy (ASAP) Program. Under this program, for every \$500 our council donates to an individual pregnancy resource center (up to \$2,000), the Supreme Council will donate \$100.

Baby bottles will be distributed after Masses on the weekend of May 4th and 5th (the weekend before Mother's Day weekend) and will be collected at masses two weeks later, on the weekend of May 18th and 19th. Please consider signing up to help distribute and collect the baby bottles on these two weekends. Your help would be very much appreciated!

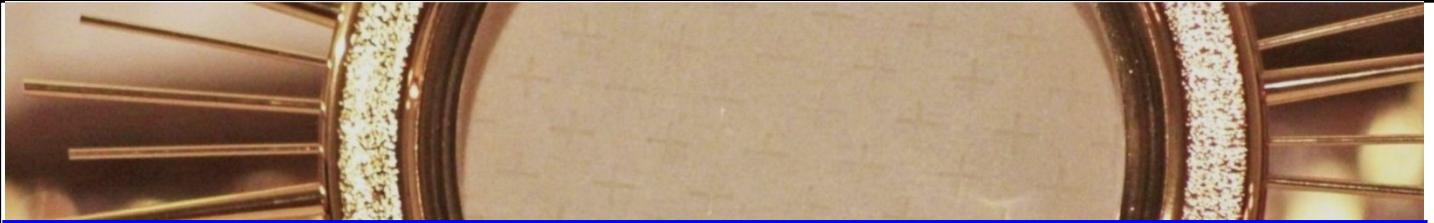

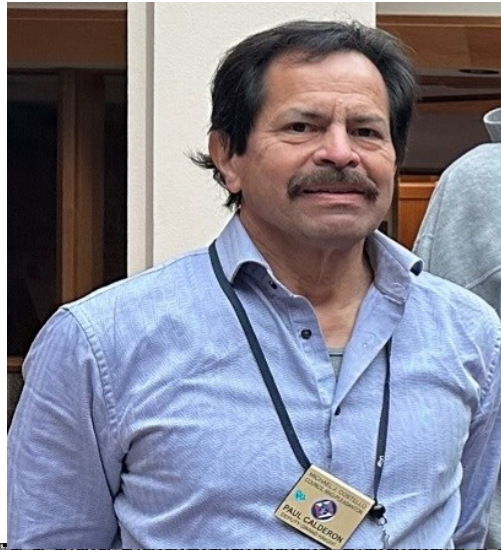
