Fr. Gerald Pedrera has joined the Catholic Community of Pleasanton as Associate Pastor. We are grateful for his ministry to our faith home! [NOTE: Fr. G is not yet a Brother Knight]. Here are a few words from Fr. Pedrera:



I joined the Diocese of Oakland in 2009 as a pastoral student. I stayed at St. Francis of Assisi in Concord and spent a year there. It was an amazing experience and I'm grateful to the people of St. Francis for their friendship, support and care—from that time until now.

After studying for a year at St. Patrick's in Menlo Park, CA, I was ordained in 2011 as a deacon (March 19th at St. Francis of Assisi in Concord) and a priest (May 14th at the Oakland Cathedral) both by now Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone, then the bishop of Oakland. My first assignment was at St. Leander Church (San Leandro), followed by Bishop O'Dowd High School (Oakland), St. Callistus (El Sobrante), St. Isidore (Danville—where I stayed the longest), and St. Anne (Union City). It is also a blessing that I have the opportunity to journey with the Tri-Valley Korean Catholic Community (TVKCC) since they started in Pleasanton. Starting August 1st of this year, I have the privilege to join the Catholic Community of Pleasanton.

All throughout my ministry, the greatest gift I enjoy is the opportunity to be part of people's lives and for me to be part of theirs. I can say that I am who I am right now because of the care, support, and love of the people who shared their lives with me. For this, I am forever grateful. I hope that in the process, in as much as they've been a blessing to me, I've been one to them.

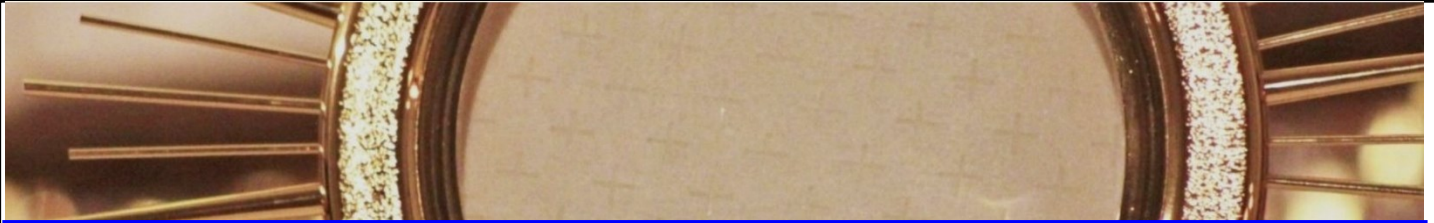

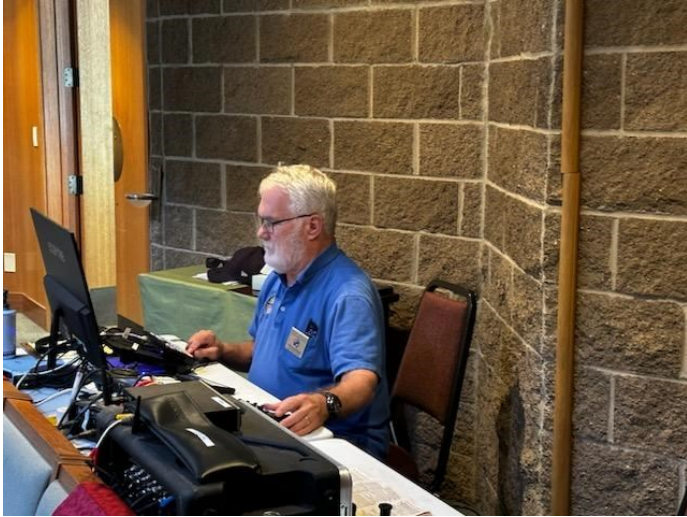
