

## Notes from the Worthy Deputy Grand Knight

My dear Brothers in Christ,

I would like to take a few minutes to ask my Brothers for help in setting up the structure of our council for the next Columbian Year 2021-2022. While it sounds far into the future (2022? Really?), it begins on July 1, 2021.

Most of our present officers plan to stay involved as officers next year, or take another position. But here is where we need help:

1) Chancellor, an officer position and 2) Membership Director, an appointed position. For the last 3+ years, the Chancellor has also served as the Membership Director, not an officer position, but who works with the Chancellor to foster membership growth. I would like to see these positions filled separately this year, as it spreads the effort. It also helps having two points of view and more ideas generated.

We will also need appointed Directors for all for areas of our Faith In Action programs:

- Faith Director
- Family Director
- Community Director
- Life Director

These positions are designed to encourage programs in their respective areas. Some programs are suggested by the Supreme Council, and others by our local council (and some have been traditions for a long time). The Directors will work with the Grand Knight and Deputy Grand Knight to choose and implement programs in their respective areas. Where I see the Directors serving is primarily as a liaison between those who run individual programs and the Deputy Grand Knight.

Please prayerfully consider stepping in to help with these needs to make our council continue it's excellent record of service to our Pastor, our Parish and our Community. You may contact me with questions or concerns about these positions.


