If you see the moon, you will see the beauty of God...

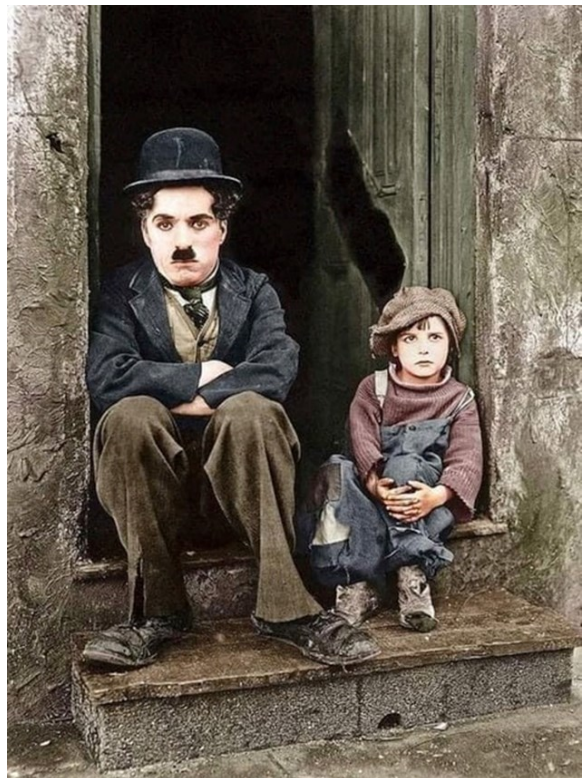


