Notes from the Worthy Deputy Grand Knight

My dear Brothers in Christ,

The 2020-2021 Columbian Year is winding down, and we are in a bit of a lull in our council activities.

Faith

We continue to support our Pastor and parish in the logistical management of our Sacraments:

Reconciliation, Eucharist distribution and Mass. Brother Mario Butzner is still managing the CCOP podcast effort. There are still opportunities to support our online Mass, funerals and other events that need audio/visual support. Knights are helping with this effort but could use more Knights to lighten the load.

Life-

Please sign up to help with our Baby Bottle fundraiser to furnish a new ultrasound machine to Real Options in Pleasanton, a crisis pregnancy center supporting expectant mothers. We will pass out baby bottles on Mothers Day after Masses and Walk-up Eucharist; parishioners will fill with cash or check, and return in 3 weeks. Goal is \$7500, 25% of the cost of the machine. The balance is matched 100% by State and 200% Supreme, for a total of \$30,000. (Our state council has helped in providing over 100 ultrasound machines to crisis pregnancy centers).

Community-

Several Knights from our council continue to collect extra food from local Safeway stores and distribute it to two senior housing communities in Pleasanton. Many seniors are on fixed incomes, and the extra food helps them budget more money for other needs.

Family-

Please contribute your ideas to help us expand our outreach to family life in our council, parish and community.

Thank you all, Brothers, for your participation in our council. For those that have not participated on a recent event, please consider joining us if your health, family and economic circumstances allow you.

Life Is Precious

The Knights of Columbus have committed their council to furnish a new ultrasound machine for a crisis pregnancy center called REAL OPTIONS. This is a caring, effective medical center comprised of five branches surrounding the Bay Area with two in Union City and Oakland.

No tool or machine is more effective in helping a woman in a crisis pregnancy reach a life affirming decision than seeing her baby on a screen via an ultrasound. Together with these images and the tender care given by the personnel of medical centers like REAL OPTIONS, give women the courage to face their pregnancy with hope.

To learn of how Angie overcame her fears in her crisis pregnancy at REAL OPTIONS please read accompany story.

Our goal is to raise \$7,500 which represents 25% of the cost of an ultrasound. The remaining balance will be furnished by two other K.C. branches. Baby bottles will be on display for pick up on Mother's Day outside of St. Augustine and St. Elizabeth Seton. If you have the means and wish to make a donation please fill these bottles with your coins, currency or checks payable to the Knights of Columbus #6043 and return them back to the church three weeks later on Sunday May 30th. Angie's Story

This pregnancy was not expected. I have two children, my son 10 and my daughter 3 and being divorced with two already, I was contemplating not going through with my pregnancy and having an abortion thinking that was my only option cause I have two already and how am I going to provide for another one? Doing it on my own, I would really be stretched thin so I looked up Planned Parenthood here in Mt. View. Went in there . They give you a blood test and I just started breaking down crying. They asked me, do you just need a minute? Gave me a minute, tissue and took me into the ultrasound room. They turned the monitor so you can't see it. I had to see. There's just a nagging feeling...I can't do it. So once they showed me the ultrasound ,...I can't...there was no way and I walked out. It was something, I was still struggling with like I said you losing all my sleep over it. Can I do it? Can I not do it?

I called Real Options, made an appointment and spoke to Lee Ann. Like I said, I walk around in denial, numbing all my feelings. I broke down, spoke to her for about an hour. She shared her story with me and it was just a relief. It just felt like you're not cornered. There are options, you can do it. I had another ultrasound. I could see the baby moving...oh my God! There's no way. This my baby. It is a part of me! It's alive! He's moving!

Being able to come here and talk to someone, someone who can relate and tell you, you know what, we're going to pray for you and here we can see what resources we have. We can help you. After leaving here, went to church that night, took the kids and even the message spoke to me. You can do it. I've been doing it for two, one more is not going to hurt. I'm excited!

At the end of her pregnancy Angie delivered a healthy baby.
