God is Faithful!

September 29 th The feast of the Arch Angels!

I remember as a child saying this prayer every night. " *Angel of God my guardian dear. To whom God's love entrusts me here. Ever this day be at my side, to Light, to guard, to rule and guide.*" A powerful prayer for a pre teen growing up in the 50's.

"Angel" comes from the Latin *angelus*, meaning **Messenger of God**. St Augustine says: "Angel is the name of their office, not of their nature. If you seek the name of their nature, it is spirit; if you seek the name of their office, it is angel; from what they are, spirit, from what they do angel. " With their whole being the angels are servants and messengers of God. Because they "always behold the face of my Father who is in heaven" they are the "mighty ones who do this word, hearkening to the voice of his word". (ccc 329)

The word "angel" then simply describes what they do not who they are. A battle cry for all of us as Knights. Arc Angel's in scripture are **messengers**. We as practicing Catholic gentleman are messengers for our faith and messengers for God's holy word, the scriptures. It is also important that they like Saint Michael are battle ready to fight for truth! To the point for fighting the one closest to God, Satan to put him in his place so to speak, out of Heaven.

Do you know your guardian angel? Are you ready for the Angelic message as for told in Revelations? When the existence of God is widely doubted, it just seems unscientific to believe in spiritual beings. The Fall campaign began only a few days ago on Wednesday Sept. 23rd on the sidewalk in front of Planned Parenthood in Walnut Creek. The first two days were uneventful, employing prayer, witnessing to life with our presence and attempting to employ sidewalk counseling to the women entering and leaving this facility.

Friday turned out to be very different and dramatic. One woman left in an ambulance, another in a wheelchair-had to be lifted up into her car and sent on her way. Later in the mid afternoon a small group of young males showed up to try and intimidate the pro lifers with a counter protest. This group taunted them, filmed them with cameras and used vile language when addressing them. The pro lifers responded by praying the rosary "loudly and proudly". Eventually after a little more than an hour these counter protesters left. "They wanted to get a reaction from us and all they got was a rosary!"

Towards the end of the day a police van showed up and parked in Planned Parenthood's driveway. The officer was quite nice and friendly and thanked them for being there. He said he believed their group prayers at P.P. in the past were a major factor in his ex wife deciding not to abort his daughter. They told him they would keep him, his daughter and ex wife in prayer.

The most evident thing present on Friday was the power of prayer in the face of evil. It helped the pro lifers respond appropriately to the taunting.
