The Fall 2022 40 Days for Life Campaign is taking place from September 28 to November 6. This campaign involves 40 days of visible, public, prayer vigils outside a Planned Parenthood center or other abortion facility in the community. It is a peaceful and educational presence, with no offensive signs. Those who are called to stand witness during this vigil witness to the sanctity of life and send a powerful message to the community about the tragic reality of abortion. With the help of the Holy Spirit we will change hearts and perhaps offer a woman a last chance for help in a crisis pregnancy.

### **CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION I ON BALLOT IN NOVEMBER**

This proposition would enshrine the most extreme forms of abortion into the state constitution. The California Catholic Conference vehemently opposes this proposition, which would solidify and protect abortion on demand up to the moment of birth, with no medical reason necessary, and supported by taxpayer funds. This measure would align California with only a handful of countries in the world, including China and North Korea, rather than the vast majority of western democracies which do not allow elective late-term abortions.

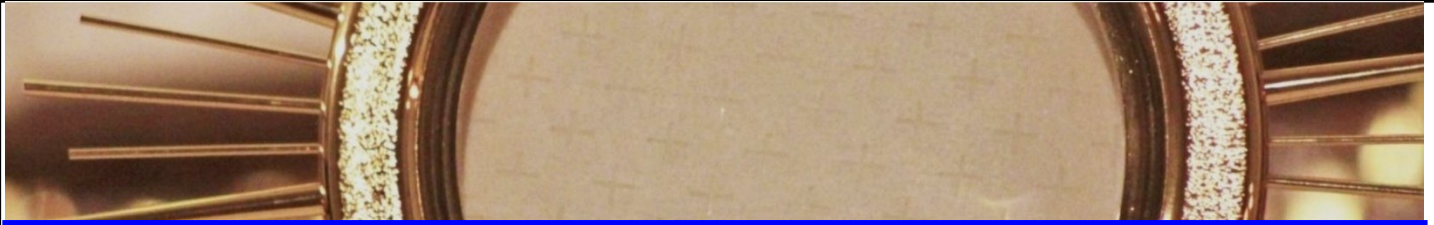
