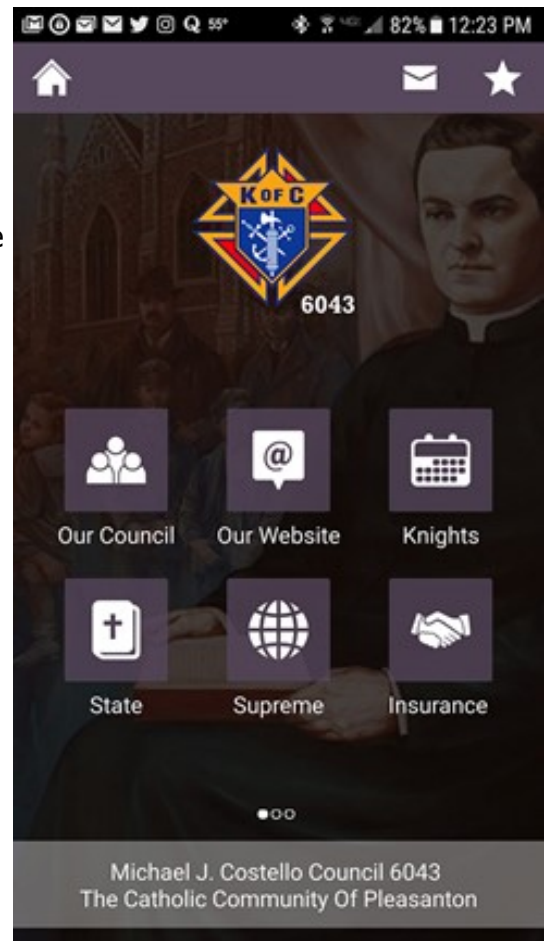
- Open the App Store App

### A Story from One of Our Volunteers

I was able to talk extensively to a young couple going in for a pregnancy test. It's not often that young couples are receptive to hearing what we have to say and offer, as you all know

Anyway, as long as they were interested, I kept talking. I asked them their names and what they were going in for (it's amazing how my seemingly bold and intrusive questions get an answer!). I explained how abortions are the primary goal of Planned Parenthood and how they're not interested in truly helping the whole person. I said that if they were, indeed, pregnant, that PP will persuasively move them into an appointment for an abortion and that they don't really care about helping a woman carry her pregnancy to term. If they were indeed pregnant, I even asked them to test PP to see what services they would offer them if they said they wanted to keep their baby. I told them the story of a young woman who was never given information by PP on keeping her pregnancy when she tested positive. Instead they gave her only abortion options. When she told them she was keeping the pregnancy going, they basically showed her the door.

That young woman was me. I told them my story and how I thought my parents would disown me and that my life was basically wrecked. But I told them how I gave my baby up for adoption and how she is a college graduate, and a beautiful, successful young woman today. And not aborting her gave her that chance. Earlier, this couple told me their names. Well, I looked directly into the eyes of the mother and told her she had the same name as my baby!

They took my brochure and proceeded up the stairs to PP but, much to our surprise, they remained out on the entrance deck for well over 20 minutes. On the sidewalk, we had never prayed so hard! We just kept praying strings of Hail Mary's—we couldn't even focus on a Rosary.

Well, to our amazement, they turned around and walked down the stairs out of the "clutches" of that horrendous place! As they were driving out, I approached their car and the boyfriend actually asked for my cell phone number I happily gave it to him and told them they could call me any time and that we can help them along the way. Even the other volunteer noticed how relieved and joyful their demeanor was!

Holy Spirit, guide and protect this young couple on their journey of LIFE.

## Safe Environment Training for Council Members

A message to the Grand Knight from Lee Ann Harper, Office of Youth Protection, Manager, KofC Supreme

*As a general matter, the Knights of Columbus expects that those participating in Knights of Columbus sponsored youth programs or activities on diocesan/parish property comply with diocesan safe environment policies. The Order's main concern is that knights cooperate with diocese and be compliant with the diocesan policies for volunteers using diocesan/parish property. We encourage our members to comply with applicable diocesan safe environment requirements when using parish/diocesan property.*

*If you discover that a knight is conducting a Knights sponsored youth program on diocesan/parish property without having completed applicable diocesan safe environment requirements, we would expect and understand that you would act to prohibit him from continued participation in our youth program on diocesan/parish property. For the Order, it is sufficient reason for a parish or diocese to prohibit a Knights sponsored youth program because the participating members leading the youth program have not complied with the diocesan requirements, even if they have completed the requirements of the Knights of Columbus Safe Environment Program.*

*The Knights of Columbus Safe Environment Program training and/or background screening is in addition to the diocesan requirements. We take seriously our obligation to ensure compliance with our Safe Environment Program. On a weekly basis we review member compliance and follow up directly with members and their grand knights when members are noncompliant. When members are noncompliant they are removed from their youth serving roles.*

The Diocese of Oakland requires that all volunteers be trained to recognize and respond to the signs of abuse, to be informed of the reporting procedures and to learn how to safeguard the children and vulnerable adults in their care. Training is available thru VIRTUS and can be done on line or at a live training. Registration for either is mandatory. Trainings are available in Spanish and English. Check out the diocesan website for more information.

Bottom-line: we must follow the request of the Diocese and ALL VOLUNTEERS MUST take their training The knights training is in addition to the diocesan requirements.

The parish website includes a page on the training [<http://www.catholicsofpleasanton.org/safe-environment.html>]. The information on that page seems to cover most of the information on the comparable page for the Diocese [<https://www.oakdiocese.org/offices/safe-environment/safe-environment-and-victims-assistance?searchterm=safe+environment+training>]. The Diocese page does include access to locations scheduled for live training.

State Deputies, grand knights, and faithful navigators (if their assemblies sponsor a Columbian Squires Circle) are required to complete Praesidium's Armatus© youth protection training to help ensure that they understand the policies and procedures that members of the Knights of Columbus are expected to follow regarding the safety and well-being of young people served through the Order's programs and activities.

- The student must be enrolled in an accredited high school in the Tri-Valley community;
- The student must have a grade point average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale;
- The student must submit the application and all required documentation by the stated deadline.
- Parent or Grandparent must be a current member in good standing with Council 6043

### SECTION 3: REQUIRED DOCUMENTS & CHECKLIST

Completed submissions will contain the following four (4) documents:

1. A completed Knights of Columbus Council #6043 Application (this form) that is signed and submitted with the required documents (listed below);
2. In 250 words or less, please explain how this scholarship award will help you achieve your educational and career goals. Specifically, your essay should indicate what college or university you are planning to attend, what you plan to study, and what career path you have chosen.
3. One letter of recommendation from a teacher or school official (preferably on letterhead) that affirms your character.
4. A copy of your school transcript that shows your cumulative GPA (an unofficial copy is acceptable).

### SECTION 4: DUE DATE & AWARD DISBURSEMENT

1. All scholarship materials must be submitted to the Grand Knight and postmarked or timestamped no later than 11:59 PM on April 30, 2018. Hardcopies can be mailed to: *K of C #6043*

2. All disbursements will be released to recipients after the council receives proof of enrollment.
3. If available, students will be honored at school awards ceremonies as well as at a Knights of Columbus council meeting with his or her parents (or guardians).
