As a GUEST, you will be asked by your host to bring a hors d'oeuvre for cocktail hour or a salad, vegetable, etc., for dinner.





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Update on Brother Jeff Techenor

Jeff Tichenor was a past Warden and a very active member of our Council. He was also a 4th Degree Knight and a member of the Color Corps. He retired and migrated to the Philippines a number of years ago.

He has been having numerous health issues and the results of an recent angiogram revealed two severe blockages (one at 90%, the other 70%) in the right artery at the lower portion of his heart. Highly expensive Angioplasty procedure to insert two stents was the recommended treatment.

Thanks to our wonderful loving Father, and in response to everyone's prayers, Jeff's reports that one of his dear friends & Brother Knight is the Vice President of the US firm that manufactures the stents & other supplies needed for Jeff's operation. The company donated all the stents at no cost through their Philippines distributor. The results was a 65% medical cost reduction and made it possible for Jeff to have the necessary operation.

Sir Knight Jeff is happy to report he is in recovery mode, feels like a new man and wishes to thank everyone for the thoughts & prayers.


