Most kids decide to leave by the time they are 13 years of age. We, the laity, must step up to the challenge of stopping this outflow and restoring public confidence in the Catholic Faith. The very existence of our Church depends upon our efforts at this critical time.

Wrap your head around this crisis and dedicate your sincere efforts to showing your parish, your community, and our country what it really means to be Catholic. In time, others will take notice and once again view our Church with the dignity and respect it deserves. But know this will be a long haul that extends through the rest of our natural lives and beyond.
