Grand Knight's Message

Merry Christmas Worthy Brothers & Families,

"For I was hungry, and you gave me food; I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink; I was a stranger and you welcomed me; I was naked and you gave me clothing; I was sick and you took care of me; I was in prison and you visited me" - Matthew 25:35-36

Just within the last month, our Council membership has distributed Thanksgiving food baskets to the needy (hungry and you gave me food); welcomed Fr. Paul as our Chaplain (our Council was thirsty for his spiritual leadership); opened the door to 20 new Brothers (welcomed in 20 strangers); assisted with the Ron Silva coat distribution (provided clothing to the homeless); coordinated the blood drive (sick and you took care of me); will be hosting Breakfast with Santa (from where toys will be given to Santa Rita inmates for their families). No other passage defines and emulates the many unconditional charitable offerings that our Council members get involved in. How profound that our charitable activities so closely mirrors one of the greatest Bible passages.

Eight brothers, two of them serving at this event for the first time, helped distribute coats, gloves, socks & pants to the homeless after they were served breakfast. It's truly a heartfelt feeling to witness the thankful faces as they receive their coats & other garments to help keep them warm in the upcoming winter months.

Within a little over an hour and with the outstanding assistance from 28 members (including 11 new Brother Knights), over 250 boxes of food were carted out of STA's hall and sent to be delivered to 73 needy local homes. What a sight it was to see our members and their families in action and to later hear wonderful heartfelt comments from their delivery receptions.

As we enter the great Advent season, let's all take time to make ourselves ready for the coming of the Christ child, and recall memories of God's wonderful movement in our lives. The spiritual journey toward Christmas is a seasonal focus of Thanksgiving, sharing & renewal as we are open to the grace of the Holy Spirit when we gather around and break bread on our family tables. 




