

Some research of the life of Christ our Lord by searching on the term "Catholic theology "???

Everyone is entitled to his or her right to skepticism, but if you fail to accept the challenge of considering this, you will be depriving yourself of knowledge of an extraordinary puzzle. This remarkable puzzle, which involves eighteen lost years or "Hidden Years" in the life of Jesus, may well turn out to be a cornerstone for understanding many enigmas about Christianity — like the long-ignored missing but somehow obvious clue in a mystery that remains unsolved. Or perhaps somehow it will eventually be proven a dead end by indisputable dating of documents, DNA testing and other scientific tests and tools. Either way, none of us will be the worse for the truly incredible journey to inquire and discover what can be surmised about Jesus' Lost Years by taking the questions right to the ancient temple of the Hindus called Jagannath in Puri, India, where some say Jesus spent several years (the "some" include the present spiritual leader of the Hindu religion, the Shankaracharya) and a Buddhist monastery high in the Himalayas in Ladakh, India, where an ancient scroll has long been held to exist that purportedly answers all the questions about the Missing Years of Jesus (see: www.jesus-in-india-the-movie.com)

Bartholomew or Nathanael

Bartholomew Nathanael, son of Talmai, lived in Cana of Galilee. His apostolic symbol is three parallel knives. Tradition says he was a missionary in Armenia. A number of scholars believe that he was the only one of the 12 disciples who came from royal blood, or noble birth. His name means Son of Tolmai or Talmai(2 Samuel 3:3). Talmai was king of Geshur whose daughter, Maacah, was the wife of David, mother of Absolom.

Bartholomew's name appears with every list of the disciples (Matthew 10:3; Mark 3:18; Luke 6:14; Acts 1:13). This was not a first name, however; it was his second name. His first name probably was Nathanael, whom Jesus called "An Israelite indeed, in whom there is no The New Testament gives us very little information about him Tradition indicates he was a great searcher of the Scripture and a scholar in the law and the prophets. He developed into a man of complete surrender to the

Carpenter of Nazareth, and one of the Church's most adventurous missionaries. He is said to have preached with Philip in Phrygia and Hierapolis; also in Armenia. The Armenian Church claims him as its founder and martyr. However, tradition says that he preached in India, and his death seems to have taken place there. He died as a martyr for his Lord. He was flayed alive with knives.

Safe Environment Training for Council Members

A message to the Grand Knight from Lee Ann Harper, Office of Youth Protection, Manager, KofC Supreme

As a general matter, the Knights of Columbus expects that those participating in Knights of Columbus sponsored youth programs or activities on diocesan/parish property comply with diocesan safe environment policies. The Order's main concern is that knights cooperate with diocese and be compliant with the diocesan policies for volunteers using diocesan/parish property. We encourage our members to comply with applicable diocesan safe environment requirements when using parish/diocesan property.

If you discover that a knight is conducting a Knights sponsored youth program on diocesan/parish property without having completed applicable diocesan safe environment requirements, we would expect and understand that you would act to prohibit him from continued participation in our youth program on diocesan/parish property. For the Order, it is sufficient reason for a parish or diocese to prohibit a Knights sponsored youth program because the participating members leading the youth program have not complied with the diocesan requirements, even if they have completed the requirements of the Knights of Columbus Safe Environment Program.

The Knights of Columbus Safe Environment Program training and/or background screening is in addition to the diocesan requirements. We take seriously our obligation to ensure compliance with our Safe Environment Program. On a weekly basis we review member compliance and follow up directly with members and their grand knights when members are noncompliant. When members are noncompliant they are removed from their youth serving roles.

The Diocese of Oakland requires that all volunteers be trained to recognize and respond to the signs of abuse, to be informed of the reporting procedures and to learn how to safeguard the children and vulnerable adults in their care. Training is available thru VIRTUS and can be done on line or at a live training. Registration for either is mandatory. Trainings are available in Spanish and English. Check out the diocesan website for more information.

Bottom-line: we must follow the request of the Diocese and ALL VOLUNTEERS MUST take their training The knights training is in addition to the diocesan requirements.

The parish website includes a page on the training

The information on that page seems to cover most of the information on the comparable page for the Diocese [https://www.oakdiocese.org/offices/safe-environment/safe-environment-and-victims-assistance?searchterm=safe+environment+training]. The Diocese page does include access to locations scheduled for live training.

State Deputies, grand knights, and faithful navigators (if their assemblies sponsor a Columbian Squires Circle) are required to complete Praesidium's Armatus© youth protection training to help ensure that they understand the policies and procedures that members of the Knights of Columbus are expected to follow regarding the safety and well-being of young people served through the Order's programs and activities.

The Pitfalls of Replacing Coverage

You know the old saying, "the grass seems greener on the other side of the fence," but we all know that it rarely is. The same holds true when it comes to replacing your existing Knights of Columbus life insurance with coverage offered by another company. Perceptions are deceiving. A move to the "greener" grass on the other side of the fence might seem like a good one, but it can leave you with less *green* in your wallet — in some cases, a lot less. That's why it pays to remember another old adage, "Read the fine print."

There are many reasons to keep your existing coverage in force, whether that coverage is with the Knights of Columbus or with another company. I'll focus on the potential pitfalls of replacing coverage here — pitfalls that an agent trying to convince you that the grass actually is greener might neglect to mention.

First, all life insurance contracts contain a *contestability period*, which allows the insurer to contest claims made for a period — typically two years — after the contract is issued. Chances are this is no longer an issue with your current coverage.

Second, it's unlikely that you can obtain the same amount of coverage, for the same premium, that you were able to obtain with your existing contract. The two factors that determine how much you'll need to pay for life insurance coverage are age and health. Certainly, you're older now than you were when you took out your current coverage. There's no way around that. And you have to ask yourself, has your health changed during that time? Is your blood pressure the same? Your cholesterol? Have you gained weight? All these factors can affect the amount of coverage you'll get for your premium dollar.

If someone encourages you to replace — or worse, drop — your existing coverage, please call me. I'll show you how your existing coverage is working for you and why replacement is rarely in your best interest.
