Grand Knight's Message

Welcome to the Columbian Year 2019-2020. The Council entrusted me with much responsibility, and I appreciate your confidence in electing me Grand Knight. Thank you. I bring to bear leadership skills, passion and personality to ensure that Council 6043 keeps flying high, navigates the significant changes required by the Diocese & Supreme, and communicates efficiently toward success.

This year will be remembered for two significant changes:

We will on-board a new Pastor and Associate; and will determine how best to work together in short order. Having worked through regular leadership rotations in my military career, I know that our Council has the system for success regardless of who sits in the cockpit. This system will remain as we support the Pastor and officially communicate through a single channel – the Grand Knight. As the first to work with Fr. Mark's, I will establish a solid relationship where he can trust and depend on the Council. Expect me to tap many of you for advice in that regard.

The other significant change involves regrouping activities and resources into Supreme's *FAITH IN ACTION* program model. Some of you heard the basics at the June 27th Officer's meeting. Activities are the same; resource allocation is different. The leadership structure now mirrors the program model. And the directors have a) more responsibility due to a larger grouping of activities, and b) more latitude to enlist whomever they need to accomplish the objectives. It's my duty as GK to deconflict the activities and manage the workload to prevent burnout. I believe in keeping things simple: get activity topics on the agenda, plan/discuss/decide, assemble the resources, then execute. In addition to the familiar agenda format from the business meetings, I'm adding a Parking Lot where new topics could become new business for Council consideration. This is an important feature in my organizational system because we carefully consider new targets without hindering the momentum of current efforts. (Continued on next page)
