

#### Rev. Paul Minnihan, Pastor and Council Chaplain, Passes

Fr. Paul D. Minnihan was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Oakland in 1993. After an additional year of graduate studies, he was assigned to the Catholic Community of Pleasanton in 1994 as parochial vicar (associate pastor). After further educational and pastoral experience, in 2006 the Bishop of Oakland invited Minnihan to serve as first Provost for the yet-to-be-built Oakland Cathedral of Christ the Light and be the Bishop of Oakland's master of ceremonies.

As Provost, he sat on the diocesan cathedral design team, given charge of certain aspects of liturgical art and environment. Fr. Paul had oversight of the month long dedication events for the Diocese, both ecclesial and civic gatherings. He was chief spokesperson for the bishop on the Cathedral highlighting the interaction of architecture, art and theology.

In addition, he was named Director of Worship for the diocese in 2010. At that time, Father oversaw the preparation and implementation of the new translation of the Roman Missal in Oakland. He coordinated programs of formation for parishes on the celebration of the mass and to pray the new missal.

Prior to this particular ministry, Fr. Paul was the Pastor at St. Paschal Baylon parish in Oakland, St. Monica parish in Moraga and St. Jerome parish in El Cerrito. He served on Priest Councils for the Diocese of Oakland. Also, he was California State Chaplain to the Knights of Columbus, is a member of the Knights of the Holy Sepulchre and was appointed a member to the United States Bishop's Commission on Evangelization.

Minnihan has a Bachelor's degree in philosophy, Master's in Theology and an STD/PhD in Systematic Theology from the Catholic University in Louvain, Belgium.

In March of 2013, he was appointed Pastor of the Catholic Community of Pleasanton where his priestly journey began.

Fr. Paul died February 24, 2019

### Council Plans for Fr. Paul's Vigil/Funeral Mass

#### Brothers,

Our Council has been asked to help with Fr. Paul's Funeral. This is a work in progress with the Parish so there may be some details that will be worked out later but this should give you all a pretty good idea of what we have been called upon to do. I am sure you will be honored to participate in whatever way you can. For those that cannot attend, please pray when we do so the Lord can hear our voices loud and clear.

On Thursday at 4:15 please arrive outside of St. Augustine's wearing your Blue Shirts and Name Badges and we will escort Fr. Paul's casket into the church for the vigil. After the procession you can sit anywhere you can unless we have a designated section of the church for the Knights. The seating is yet to be determined. The officers will guide you with the lineup etc.

The plan is to leave Fr. Paul in the church all night. At the end of the vigil the church will be locked and the officers will be with Fr. Paul till Midnight when other members will be with Fr. Paul for the rest of the evening. You should have received a Signup Genius invitation to be part of this. In other words you can sign up individually to be with Fr. Paul for a 2 hour shift by responding to the invitation or go to

https://www.signupgenius.com/go/9040e48adaa2ba64-allnight now to signup. The number of Knights will be limited to 8 for each of the 4 two hour shifts and the number in the church will be strictly adhered to per request of the Parish. Please read the rules carefully before signing up.

On Friday the Mass will begin at 10:30. Wear your Blue Shirts and Name Badges if you are attending the Mass. At the end of the Mass we will escort the casket to the hearse similar to what the priests provided at Fr. Dan's funeral. The lineup will be directed by the officers. They will let you know when to go out of the church for the lineup and how to setup. The casket will then go to another service at the Cathedral in Oakland.

After the Mass there will be a reception in the Hall were we will provide beverage refreshments for those who go there. Knights who will help with this are being contacted directly.

That's it. There maybe some details that need to be worked out but the officers and myself will let you know on each day what needs to be done.

God Bless you all. Let's make this a respectful send off for our Pastor who has served us well and who allowed us to serve him and our Parish in the way that we do.
