#### From the Council Lecturer/Historian

#### God is Faithfull

April 12, 2019

#### THE WAY OF THE CROSS

I have been asked to offer a reflection and history of the "Way of the Cross" or "Stations of the Cross" officially entitled "Via Dolorosa" (Sorrowful Way).

Tradition tells us that Our Blessed Mother visited daily the scenes of the Passion of Our Lord, Jesus Christ. After Constantine legalized Christianity in the year 312 this "Way" was marked with these important "Stations." Saint Jerome (342-420), living in Bethlehem during the later part of his life witnessed and attested to the crowd of pilgrims from throughout the land who visited those holy places that followed the way of the cross.

In the 15th century there was an interest to reproduce the holy places in other areas so that pilgrims who <u>could not travel</u> to the Holy Land could do so in a spiritual way in their hearts.

The Franciscans in 1342 were appointed as guardians of the shrines of the Holy Land. The faithful received indulgences at these following stations.

Pilate's House

Where Christ Met His Mother

Where He spoke to the women

Where Simon of Cyrene helped to carry the Cross

Where the Soldiers stripped Him of His garments

Where He was nailed to the Cross

At the Tomb

In the 17th century Pope Innocent XI (11) in 1686 erected stations in all of the churches and Pope Benedict XIII (13) in 1726 extended these indulgences to all of the faithful due to previous Moslem oppression. Five years later Pope Clement XII (12) permitted stations in All churches and fixed the number of stations at 14. Pope Benedict XIV (14) exhorted all priests to enrich their churches with the "Way of the Cross." This past century Pope Paul VI (6) approved a Gospel based version of the stations and Pope John Paul II (2) had written his own version.

I would encourage you to place a personal connotation to today's "Stations of the Cross."

Like Jesus we too are sometimes accused, mocked and judged improperly. Carry your cross all the Way.

Like Jesus we too fall once, twice, maybe 3 or more times. Then we should get up and continue on the Way.

Like Jesus we too need help from outsiders like Simon. Then we should allow others to help us to continue on the Way.

Like Jesus we too need help to wipe the face of pain, and injustice such as the action of Veronica and continue on the Way.

Like Jesus we too need to strip away the layers of sin and guilt. To preach the Gospels and show others the Way.

Remember there cannot be a resurrection of the body without a crucifixion, "The Way."


# CCoP Blood Drive Sponsored by Council 6043, Knights of Columbus
