

- Press the Get Button

- Wait for the configuration to complete

Dear Friend for Life,

You won't believe this! Here is the precious story from our vigil in Walnut

Creek yesterday!

"I was going to get rid of them....but I just couldn't do it!" These were the words of a young--almost 19 year old woman--who came toward me on the sidewalk about 15 minutes after walking up the ramp and into the Planned Parenthood Building. She had been scheduled for an abortion at around 11am this Friday morning, and appeared to ignore my initial offering of help; of information and resources as she walked into the building without looking at me. Another one lost, I thought. And, then I added my own silent prayer, "Lord, please help her, and help her baby." My heart sighed as I turned back to our group, and said goodbye to a couple of vigil volunteers who were changing shifts. But then, just a short 15 minutes after entering, I saw the same young woman with her friend exiting the building. And she directly walked over to our small group of 4 on the sidewalk. I went up to her, smiled and said, "Would you like some information about free pregnancy resources in our area?" And she replied, "Yes, yes I would." So, I launched into the resources that we had available in the flyer, pointing out the different stages of development, the risks of abortion to women (both physical and emotional) and indicated where she could go for free pregnancy care, testing, etc. During the course of our dialogue I asked her if she knew how far along she was, and she smiled and said yes, "12 weeks. They're 12 weeks old." I did a double take, and said "Twins? You know they're twins?!" And, she said, "Yes! I had an ultrasound at a clinic in Antioch, and they scheduled me today for an abortion here. I was going to get rid of them...but I just couldn't do it!" "Oh my goodness...thank God!" I exclaimed. I told her, "You will be SO relieved with your decision to give them life." And she agreed. In fact her friend, referencing the info on the pamphlet then exclaimed, "Your babies have FINGERNAILS!" I will NEVER forget that moment, that line, and that realization that they both had that these were babies growing inside her. It humanized her babies for her.

So praise God, praise His timing,

praise His and Our Blessed Mother's intercession.

Life is beautiful, life is precious, and yes, life has fingernails!

Safe Environment Training for Council Members

A message to the Grand Knight from Lee Ann Harper, Office of Youth Protection, Manager, KofC Supreme

As a general matter, the Knights of Columbus expects that those participating in Knights of Columbus sponsored youth programs or activities on diocesan/parish property comply with diocesan safe environment policies. The Order's main concern is that knights cooperate with diocese and be compliant with the diocesan policies for volunteers using diocesan/parish property. We encourage our members to comply with applicable diocesan safe environment requirements when using parish/diocesan property.

If you discover that a knight is conducting a Knights sponsored youth program on diocesan/parish property without having completed applicable diocesan safe environment requirements, we would expect and understand that you would act to prohibit him from continued participation in our youth program on diocesan/parish property. For the Order, it is sufficient reason for a parish or diocese to prohibit a Knights sponsored youth program because the participating members leading the youth program have not complied with the diocesan requirements, even if they have completed the requirements of the Knights of Columbus Safe Environment Program.

The Knights of Columbus Safe Environment Program training and/or background screening is in addition to the diocesan requirements. We take seriously our obligation to ensure compliance with our Safe Environment Program. On a weekly basis we review member compliance and follow up directly with members and their grand knights when members are noncompliant. When members are noncompliant they are removed from their youth serving roles.

The Diocese of Oakland requires that all volunteers be trained to recognize and respond to the signs of abuse, to be informed of the reporting procedures and to learn how to safeguard the children and vulnerable adults in their care. Training is available thru VIRTUS and can be done on line or at a live training. Registration for either is mandatory. Trainings are available in Spanish and English. Check out the diocesan website for more information.

Bottom-line: we must follow the request of the Diocese and ALL VOLUNTEERS MUST take their training The knights training is in addition to the diocesan requirements.

The parish website includes a page on the training

The Diocese page does include access to locations scheduled for live training.

State Deputies, grand knights, and faithful navigators (if their assemblies sponsor a Columbian Squires Circle) are required to complete Praesidium's Armatus© youth protection training to help ensure that they understand the policies and procedures that members of the Knights of Columbus are expected to follow regarding the safety and well-being of young people served through the Order's programs and activities.
