


seventh annual walk for life

LOCATION:	Justin Herman Plaza, Market St., SF
WHEN:	Saturday, Jan. 22, 2011
TIME:	11:00 AM
DURATION:	2 ½ miles to Marina Greens – usually takes 2 hours
MISC:	Bring a boxed lunch to eat during/while listening to the speeches



Knights of Columbus Support Needed







The City of SF can no longer pay overtime for the police officers they provided in the past. We are expected to make up the difference. If we can't provide enough people, the Walk might be cancelled.

The Knights of Columbus are handling security for the visiting dignitaries (Bishops, Priests, and Religious), radio communications, SFPD liaison, transportation assistance and crowd control. We need your help. The only qualification is that you can walk the entire route. We'd like to get a minimum of five Knights from each Council in the Oakland Chapter to participate in the following capacities:

<u>Peace Keeper</u>: Arrive between 10:00 and 11:00am and check in. Wear a safety vest and walk the route to prevent interactions with the protesters. About half of the Peace Keepers will have a radio.

<u>Group Monitor</u>: Arrive with your group and check in. Wear a Safety Vest and walk the entire way as part of your group. Ensure your group does not interact with the protesters and that they keep off the sidewalks and median strips. Notify the nearest Peace Keeper if there are problems or if someone in your group needs assistance. Ideally we need a Group Monitor for every busload of people.

Bike Rider: We will need 5-7 people to carry radio batteries, water, and first aid supplies.

Preparation: Arrive before 10:00am to help make signs and set up stage for the speakers.

Transportation Assistance: Give directions to the walkers on finding their busses after the walk.

Sponsorship: Have your Council sponsor a bus that will take people from your parish to the Walk.

Under no circumstances are any Peace Keepers or Group Monitors allowed to get into any physical altercation. Our job is to monitor and observe only. Contact a policeman if the situation warrants it. The last three years have been very peaceful. We are not expecting any trouble. However, we need a show of force with 400 people wearing the safety vests and maintaining control. If you have friends that are not Knights they are welcome to participate too.
