## "Have you considered joining the 4th Degree"

Brothers,

For most men who follow Jesus, there comes a time when duty extends beyond our own lives, beyond how we lead our families and into how we serve our fellow man. That's what the Knights of Columbus is all about. The Patriotic Degree allows K of C members to take this duty one step further.

The primary purpose of the Fourth Degree is to foster the spirit of patriotism by promoting responsible citizenship and a love of and loyalty to the Knights' respective countries through active membership in local Fourth Degree groups called Assemblies. Fourth degree members are called "Sir Knight" which is more than a title – it's an honor.

Have you considered joining the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree? You see the Fourth degree most frequently as the Color Corps, which wears uniforms modeled after the French Navy of the 18<sup>th</sup> Century, with capes, Chapeaus (the feathered hats) and swords. Not every 4<sup>th</sup> degree knight joins the Color Corps, but all 4<sup>th</sup> degree wear tuxedos for our formal events. In our area, Fourth Degree members are active participants in the East Bay Stand Down (a county wide event for homeless veterans) and the host for the annual Red, Blue and Gold Dinner which honors the efforts of local fire fighters and police officers.

This is your invitation to join the Holy Spirit Assembly 1979 which is comprised of knights from all of the five Tri-Valley Councils.

One must have been a knight for 6 months, and achieved the rank of the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree before joining the 4<sup>th</sup> degree. Any of you who became knights before August 2<sup>nd</sup> who complete the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree by December can join the 4<sup>th</sup> degree. You may take the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> degrees on October 27 in Danville. We do the Exemplification on the first weekend in February in Rohnert Park. 
