Pleasanton students Nicole Riordan, 10, and Nishanth Palanisany, 14, won the 2010 Knights of Columbus State of California free throw contest held recently in Fresno.

Nichole, a fourth-grade honor student at Mohr Elementary, is the daughter of Dan and Sarah Riordan. She won the free throw contest in Fresno with a score of 24 out of 25. She is also a Girl Scout, plus plays competitive soccer for the Pleasanton Rage and softball for the Phantom (PGSA). She is a member of the CCOP

fourth-grade girls A Team basketball team.

Nishanth, a freshman at Foothill High, is the son of Palanisamy Manicakampatty and Kalpana Palanisamy. He is a member of the freshman basketball and junior varsity tennis teams, and holds a black belt in Taekwondo. In Fresno, Nishanth made 24 out of 25 baskets,

## an invitation from Brother chris

Hi, all,

As many of you know, I am to be ordained--God willing!--to priesthood in the Catholic Church on 25 June 2010. This is on a Friday and will take place at

11 a.m. at St. Dominic Church in San Francisco.

There are two other significant events on the same weekend. First, there is the celebration of my first Mass of Thanksgiving on Saturday 26 June at St.

Albert Priory in Oakland at about noon (exact time to be determined).

Second, on Sunday 27 June at 10 am, I will serve Divine Liturgy at Our Lady of Fatima Byzantine Catholic Church in San Francisco as a priest for the first time.

If it is possible for you to attend any or all of the events above, you would be most welcome, and it would certainly put a smile on my face to see you. If you are traveling to the Bay Area, the following might be of interest.

A number of my friends and family have expressed an interest in staying in San Francisco. There is a very fine hotel called The Sir Francis Drake that has offered a block of rooms at the rate of \$119 per night for Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights. Guests are also free to pay the same rate plus or minus three days. I know that's not inexpensive, but it's a good rate in San Francisco, especially for the location.

There is a Hilton Garden Inn in Emeryville (practically speaking: Oakland) that has offered a block of rooms for \$89 per night. Transportation is more of an issue in this case, but it is significantly less expensive.

Both hotels require a minimum of ten rooms be reserved to obtain the rate.

To help me get organized with the four other men to be ordained who will also have guests, PLEASE LET ME KNOW if you might be interested in taking advantage of one of the hotel opportunities above.
